- More than 50 million Americans suffer from allergies and some don't even know it.
- 40% of kids and 30% of adults have seasonal allergies.
- Common symptoms are: sneezing, stuffy nose, post nasal drip, watery eyes and itchy nose and eyes.
- Seasonal allergies occur in the spring, summer and early fall.
- Tree, grass and weed pollen and mold are the most common triggers of seasonal allergies.
- 40% of patients with allergies also have asthma.
